- **Vocal**— rap, yodeling, pop, etc; acappella or with musical accompaniment (only voice judged)
- **Instrumental**— (only instrumental presentation judged)
- **Dance**— tap, ballet, interpretive, modern, jazz, acrobatic, folk, clogging, etc. (only dance presentation judged)
- **Drama**— play or scene from a play, monologue, mime
- **Variety**— magic acts, stand-up comics, puppetry, impressionists, ventriloquism, clowning, juggling, circus acts, tumbling/gymnastics, step, lip sync, bird calls, karate
- **Combo**— 2 or more of any of above categories, i.e. singing & dancing; singing & playing guitar (judged on all aspects of act)
